DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Exciting things continue to happen here at the museum. We completed Phase 1 of the Integrated Multi-Trophic Aquaponics (IMTA) Exhibit and had the official opening on September 21. Lt. Gov. Billy Nungesser helped us cut the ribbon. The exhibit is on the ground floor of the museum and is a closed system that simulates the river, lakes, and marshes of Louisiana. Phase 2 will consist of adding shellfish to our tanks already populated with finned fish. When that is complete, we will have a completed ecosystem of finned fish, shellfish and marsh grasses. The marsh grasses will be available, at no charge, to organizations who replant coastal Louisiana to stem loss of land that is occurring at a rapid pace here in the state. If you haven't seen it yet, you need to! The fish are always ready to greet you. NO FISHING!

With the name change approved by the Board and announced in January, the Board is now looking to state our mission more accurately, reflective of the entire state and further in terms of becoming an accredited museum. Accreditation by the American Alliance of Museums (AAM) is mandatory if we are to be viewed by professionals in the museum field (other museums) as a quality museum with high standards worthy of the public trust. One of the first tasks in beginning on the trek to accreditation was to restate our mission in terms that museum professionals, academia, and grant funding organizations recognize and accept. In the September Board Meeting, the Board

unanimously approved the following mission statement -

"Maritime Museum Louisiana inspires and engages patrons in bringing Louisiana's maritime history to life. The Museum accomplishes this by collecting, restoring, and preserving Louisianarelated maritime material culture, including artifacts, photographs, and documents. The Museum interprets these unique treasures in exhibits, dioramas, lectures, and interactive opportunities, on-and off-site. The Museum's public history interpretations are founded on scholarship. Collections are maintained in accordance with professional museum standards of care. Americans have a shared heritage, and Maritime Museum Louisiana shall preserve, impart, and embrace it.

We continue to strive to make you proud of the decision you made to join the museum, Louisiana's ONLY Maritime Museum.
